



Welcome to Awana at Calvary Baptist Church!

Dear Parents,

Thank you for your interest in the Awana Clubs at CBC. We are again participating in Awana Clubs, a great ministry that helps churches and parents work together to develop spiritually strong children and youth who faithfully follow Jesus Christ. We are excited to have your children join us!

Who can come to Awana?

- Puggles 2 and 3 year olds (non potty trained is fine)
- Cubbies: 3- and 4-year-olds (they must be 3 by September 1st and potty trained – no exceptions)
- Sparks: Kindergarten through 2nd grade
- Truth & Training (T&T): 3rd through 6th grades
- Trek: Jr. High School
- Journey: High School

When does Awana meet?

- Awana Clubs meet Tuesday nights from 6:00 to 7:30. Clubbers are encouraged to check in as early as 5:45.

Where does Awana meet?

- All clubbers are to be dropped off and checked-in in the hallway at the main entrance of the Education Building. They will also be picked up at this same location at 7:30pm.
Puggles meet in the nursery in the main church.
- Cubbies and Sparks will be staying on the first floor of the Education Building all evening, with some of the time spent in the Fellowship Hall and some of the time in their west-end classrooms.
- T&T- Journey will be spending some of the time in the Fellowship Hall and some of the time upstairs in their classroom.

Are there any costs involved?

- Registration is \$10.00 per child, with a maximum of \$30.00 per family. Replacement fee for lost handbooks, vests, or shirts is the family's responsibility. The church considers the Awana ministry a vital part of our evangelistic outreach to our own members and to the community. If the registration fee is a financial burden for your family, please let any of the Awana registration folks know, and we will work something out. What does a typical Awana Club night look like?

GAME TIME stressing healthy competition with emphasis on having fun and good sportsmanship—win or lose.

LARGE GROUP TIME with singing, activities, crafts, and teaching from God's Word in a way that is fun and relevant to the children's lives.

SMALL GROUP TIME consists of time spent with clubbers reciting Bible verses from their handbooks (memorized at home during the week).

Can I visit my child's Awana Club?

- You are more than welcome to spend an evening with your child in club. When you check in your child, just let the secretary know and she will introduce you to your child's Leader.

What can I do to help?

- It is important that your child comes prepared each week. To help ensure this, have a designated time where you study their handbook with them each week and see that they come prepared to say at least one section per club night. Also, make sure they come to Awana with their Bible, handbook, uniform, and anything needed on our special Theme Nights Watch for Theme Night handouts.
- Have your child wear sneakers and long pants (for the crawling games). Game time is much safer this way.
- Do your best to be prompt! We start the evening with Game Time at 6:00, and we know they would not want to miss out on any games.

How many verses are clubbers expected to recite each week?

- All clubbers are encouraged to complete their handbooks at their own pace. We recommend that clubbers recite 1 or 2 verses at each club meeting. This will vary depending on the age group.

How many books are clubbers expected to complete?

- Each clubber is encouraged to complete a single book at their level each school year, although there will be times when clubbers complete more than one.

Can my child bring friends to Awana?

- Absolutely! Clubbers are encouraged to bring friends whenever possible. Friends sign up at the registration table on Awana Club nights, just like regular clubbers. The friend will stay with your child through the entire Awana evening.
